Canadian Cup Dressage Festival is a sanctioned Equine Canada National Gold and Bronze Level competition member of Equine Canada, Ottawa, Ontario and is governed by the rules of the Federation.

### **Statement of Principal**

Equine Canada (EC), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The EC is committed to upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value as a primary consideration in all activities, requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment; ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors, and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment, and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose; providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a manner of standard operating procedure; continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare, requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organizations' rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions, reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

### **General Rules**

1 Every class offered herein is covered by the Rules and Specifications of the current rules of Equine Canada and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC General Regulations Rule Book-2010 edition and in particular Section E Dressage 2010. Knowledge of the rules is the responsibility of the competitor. **For all FEI Classes the 2009 FEI Dressage Tests and the 2010 Para Equestrian Tests will be used. Current 2010 EC / USEF Dressage tests** will be used for Training to Fourth Levels. Tests can be downloaded from the EC and FEI Websites: [www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca) and or [www.fei.org](http://www.fei.org)

2 Junior competitors must wear proper fitting, approved protection headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on the competition or event grounds. Approved headgear meets the ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) standards and displays the SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) seal. The British Standard, BSI, is also acceptable.

3 Any horse entered in any class at a competition subject to the requirement to pay drug testing fees may, while on the competition grounds and on the recommendation of the chairman of the provincial Equine Medication Control Committee or the chairman's appointee, be selected for equine medication control testing.

4 Neither Maple Ridge Equi Sports Center nor any member of the show committee will be held responsible in any way for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses or property of spectators, owners, trainers, riders or grooms.

5. All Owners and Riders must be current members of Equine Canada and the Provincial Equestrian Federation of residence or pay a \$30.00 non-member fee.

**Entries must include a photocopy of the owner's and riders current 2010 EC, HCBC, AEF, or USEF membership cards or an Official Receipt of Payment may be used as proof of membership where 2010 member cards Have not yet been issued. Email confirmations of membership are valid.** Members can renew memberships online at [www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca) or [www.hcbc.ca](http://www.hcbc.ca) for provincial Horse Council BC memberships. Non-members may complete a temporary sport license form along with non member payment at the show office on arrival at show. Entry Forms will be accepted at the Closing date with all fees due and payable prior to competition.

6. Valid passports with 2010 stickers for each Canadian owned horse are required for Gold rated entries and must be presented to the show secretary when picking up number(s). **Passports are not required for Bronze Competition entries.** Foreign owners or their agents must sign an affidavit verifying the horse entered on arrival.

7. The horses' competition number must be worn at all times while on MREC property while outside of stall. Failure to do so may result in a warning and repeated infractions may result in elimination.

8. Test Callers are permitted as per Equine Canada rules and must be provided by the competitor. All FEI Tests must be ridden from memory.
9. Whips to a maximum length of 1.20m may be carried.
10. Lounge whips are permitted only when lounging.
11. Whips may be carried in all classes except FEI Junior, Young Rider Qualifying classes.
12. Lounging is permitted in designated areas only.
13. Dogs must be leashed and under control at all times.
14. Wilma's Concession will be open during the day  
The Ranch Pub & Grill will be open from 11:00am

### **ENTRIES:**

15. **ENTRIES CLOSE: Tuesday, July 9, 2010.** Entries received after the closing date are subject to a Late Fee of \$30.00 payable on the entry form and may be subject to a waiting list limited to the ride times available. Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason with the returning of all fees paid.

Entries will be accepted in the order they are received.
18. Entries requiring a signature for delivery will not be accepted.
19. One horse per entry form with individual cheques for each horse entered.
20. Cheques dated after Closing date, will not be accepted and entries will be considered null and void.
21. NSF cheques are subject to a \$35.00 penalty. Cheques will be cashed prior to the start of the show and any outstanding balances with penalties must be paid in cash.
22. All competitors must sign both Entry Form and Entry Agreement Waiver.
23. Entry Confirmations may be emailed to all competitors providing an email address verifying each entry accepted and confirmed. Please review and advise of any entry corrections immediately.
24. Numbers will not be given to competitors who have outstanding entry deficiencies and/or balances. Competitors are responsible for any outstanding amounts or deficiencies when picking up numbers (e.g. miscalculations, NSF cheque replacement and fee, post entry fees and missing photocopies, etc). The Entry Secretary will attempt to contact any competitor with outstanding issues prior to the start of the show.
25. Each change to an entry after the closing date will be charged a \$10.00 change fee.
26. Please print clearly. Illegible entries will not be accepted.
27. The Show management reserves the right to limit the number of entries and or refuse any entry; split, cancel or combine and/or adjust classes or awards; to govern all conditions of the show; and to make final decisions upon any matters not covered by current Equine Canada/FEI rules.

28. The Show Schedule will try to accommodate each horse rider combination as best as possible to allow for suitable warm up time for all tests a Rider has entered. A minimum of 30 minutes between start of ride times will be scheduled if and where possible. In cases where this is not feasible in the Ride Schedule, affected Riders will be given the option of accepting the available ride time or being removed from the class and refunded the class fee.
29. Ride time schedules will be emailed to all competitors providing an email address and will also be posted at [www.mrec.ca](http://www.mrec.ca) Events
30. Final Ride Times will be posted one day prior to each Show Day on the scoreboard.
31. Ride Times may be rescheduled at any time due to unforeseen conflicts at the Show at the Show Manager's discretion. Competitors must check the scoreboard for updated Day sheets on the morning of each Show Day.
32. The Show Office will be open for pick up of numbers on Thursday, July 28 2010 between 4:00 pm and 8:00 pm. The Show Office will also open each morning 45 minutes before the start of the first ride time of each day.
33. **Schooling Horses are permitted to attend competition grounds for schooling purposes for a schooling fee of \$75.00 for the 3 day show.**
34. An Entry Form must be completed and number assigned for all schooling horses by the Entry Closing Date. Stabling charges and or Haul In fees are applicable for all schooling horses. All fees including the \$40.00 administration fee must be paid on Entry Form complete with signed Waiver. Drug Testing Fees and DC Levy Fees are not applicable for schooling horses. Late Fees are applicable after the Closing Date for all Schooling Horses.

## **CLASS RULES:**

35. Each horse may be ridden in a maximum of three classes per day for all levels.
36. All classes with 3 or more entries per category will be split accordingly into Junior/ Young Rider, Adult Amateur, and Open Classes. Where there are fewer than three entries in a class per category, classes may be combined at the discretion of Show Management.
37. Only one test of choice **per class** may be entered in all Test of Choice classes. Test of Choice classes are placed on total percentages for all tests.
38. Classes may be scheduled at any time on the day listed in the class schedule.
39. Ride times may be changed in the case of any error, overlapping times, or to facilitate the running of the show. Current Day Sheets will be posted in the morning daily on the Scoreboard and announcements will be made daily.
39. Junior/Adult Amateur/Open status: Refer to EC Rulebook for requirements.
40. **Para equestrian riders must provide a copy of their Dispensation card with their entry-** an additional copy for each test to be ridden would be appreciated. It is not necessary to provide copies of PE tests.
41. Ties will be broken by the collective marks. Ties remaining after collective marks will stay tied.

## **FREESTYLES:**

42. Music must be in CD format.
43. Freestyle Riders must provide a CD to the Show Office.
44. CD must be clearly labeled with the Rider's Name, Competition Number.
45. It is the rider's responsibility to pick CD up from the Show Office prior to the close of the show.

## **REFUNDS/POST ENTRIES:**

46. Prior to closing date, all fees with the exception of the administration fee will be refunded. **After closing date, 50% of class fees will be refunded with a vet/physician's certificate presented 24 hours prior to the start of the show. All other fees are non refundable.** No fees will be refunded after the start of the show.
47. A Late Entry fee of \$30.00 may be charged for any entries received after the closing date. Entries received prior to the closing date, when the competition is full, will be contacted and placed on a waiting list. Wait listed entries will NOT be subject to post entry fees if accepted into the show. If the competitor does not wish to stay on the wait list all fees will be returned.

## **STABLING:**

48. **Cost for the duration of the show is \$165.00 plus GST per stall. Stalls will be available from 1:00 pm Thursday July 28, 2010 for the duration of the show. Competitors wishing to arrive early must notify and have prior permission of Show Manager prior to arrival. Additional days will be charged a stabling fee of \$25.00 plus GST per day and must be paid at show office. A separate Clean out Deposit Check of \$25.00 must be included with Entry Form. Clean out deposit will not be processed where assigned stalls are stripped clean by Sunday August 1, 2010, 7 pm. Horse Bedding is provided.**
49. Stall Charts and Stall Cards will posted in the stabling area at the show.
50. A Haul in Fee of \$25.00 per each day will be charged for all horses not stabled on grounds. Haul in Trailers must park in the designated Trailer Parking Area Only.

## **AWARDS:**

### **CLASS AWARDS:**

Ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> Place. Award to First Place in all classes. Ribbons and tests may be picked up after the class is completed and the results have been posted on the scoreboard. Classes will be divided by Bronze and Gold entry and by Rider category subject to entries. All Classes with 3 or more entries per category will be split into Junior, Adult Amateur, and Open categories

### **CHAMPIONSHIPS AND RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

Championships and Reserve Championships will be awarded for each Division and Category with 3 or more competitors. A final minimum average score of 60% must be obtained to be eligible for Championship Awards. A minimum number of 3 Tests must be entered through the duration of show to be eligible for Championship awards. A final minimum average score of 58% must be obtained to be eligible for Reserve Championship. In divisions/categories with less than 3 riders the Show Committee reserves the right to alter or combine the Championships and Reserve Championships presented. When there is more than one judge the final percentage total from the panel of two Judges will count. Freestyle scores do not count towards Championships.

## **CHAMPIONSHIP CRITERIA**

Walk Trot Championship: Combined 2 Scores from the Designated Championship Classes **(C)**

Dressage Seat Equitation: Combined 2 Scores from the Designated Championship Classes **(C)**

Training to Fourth Level: The combined total of top 2 percentage technical scores from the designated Championship Classes **(C)**, one of which must be the most difficult test of the level (Training – Second: test 4, Third – Fourth: test 3)

FEI Youth (Child, Pony, Junior or Young Rider): The combined total of top 2 percentage technical scores, 1 Individual and 1 Team from the designated Championship Classes **(C)**

FEI Adult Amateur: The combined top 2 percentage technical scores of Prix St Georges and Intermediate I from the Championship Classes **(C)**

FEI Advanced: The combined top 2 percentage technical scores of Open Prix St Georges and Open Intermediate I from the Championship Classes **(C)**

FEI Grand Prix: The combined top 2 percentage technical scores of Intermediare 2, Grand Prix, and or Grand Prix Special designated Championship Classes **(C)**

Championships and Reserve Championships will be awarded once they are confirmed and posted on the scoreboard. Competitors leaving show grounds prior to posting awards will forfeit all Championship Awards. Competitors leaving grounds may designate another individual to collect Championship Awards on their behalf prior to leaving grounds.

Any decisions regarding Championship Results not specified herein the Prize List which may result in a decision or ruling will be at the sole discretion of the Show Manager and Show Committee. A High Score Freestyle Award will be presented to the single High percentage score of all the Combined Open Freestyle Classes.

## **Sport License Requirements**

### **Gold Competitors**

For all Gold Competitions, Owners and Riders must be current members of Both the National (Gold) and Provincial Equestrian Federation of residence or Pay the \$30.00 non-member fee. All entries must include a photocopy of the Owners and rider's current 2010 EC and or HCBC or AEF or USEF membership Cards. Non-members must provide a completed temporary sport license form along with their payment. Valid passports with 2010 stickers for each Canadian owned horse are mandatory for the GOLD competition and must be presented to the show secretary when picking up number(s). Foreign owners or their agents must sign an affidavit verifying the horse entered. Horses without valid passport must provide a complete temporary horse license form and pay the \$25.00 fee on arrival at the show office.

### **Bronze (only) Competitors**

All Bronze Competitors who are not competing in the Gold competition must be current members HCBC and purchase an EC Bronze Sport License. Bronze Sport Licenses may be purchased at the show office for a cost of \$ 25.00 on arrival at show office completing the EC Bronze Application Form provided and recorded by Equine Canada. NOTE: your horse is not required to have Equine Canada Horse Passport or horse license.

# Equine Canada & USEF Equestrian ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian Entry Agreement (Article 1502.4) as printed in the Prize List for this Competition and agree to all of its provisions. I understand and agree that by entering this competition, I am subject to Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition. I agree to waive the right to the use of my photos at the competition, and agree that any actions against the US Equestrian Federation must be brought in New York State. Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification.

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition "Canadian Cup Dressage Competition" to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian and Maple Ridge Equi Sports Center from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian or the Maple Ridge Equi Center

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian or the Competition Officials, Officers, Directors, Employees, volunteers, or any other affiliate organization or participant of the show.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Equine Canada/US Equestrian Federation and the Canadian Cup Dressage Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Canadian Cup Dressage Competition.

I have read the Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian Rules about protect active equipment, including Articles 318 and 1712, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian strongly encourages me that I do so. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that Equine Canada/USEF Equestrian and "Maple Ride Equi Sports Center " as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.
