MREC August Hunter Jumper Show

The show committee and Jack Polo have made some changes to the August Hunter Jumper Show.

Derbies

We will be holding the MREC Derbies on the cross-country course with a combination of solid and coloured fences over a variety of terrain. The course will be approximately 1,000 metres. The Derbies will be held on Saturday afternoon starting at approximately at 3:00 pm, after the Hunter and Jumper Rings have finished. The Derby heights are .85 metres and 1.00 metre.

Team Relays

On Friday afternoon we will be holding two MREC Team Relays. These classes will have great prizes. The first MREC Team Relay will be .85 meters (2'9") and is open to any horse/rider combination that has competed that day in classes where fence heights have not exceeded 0.90 m (3'0"). Cross-entry with the 1.00 m (3'3") MREC Team Relay is not allowed. The class will be held as per FEI Article 268.

The second Team Relay will be 1.00 m (3'3") and is open to any horse/rider combination that has competed that day in classes where fence heights have been 0.90m (3'0") or over. Cross-entry with the 0.90 m (3'0") relay is not permitted. The class will be held as per FEI Article 268.

A minimum of 8 entries per class are required in order for these events to take place.

Schooling and Warm-Up Day

The Hunter Ring will open approximately 1.5 hours before the start of the Hunter Ring and will be available for approximately 45 minutes of schooling.

On Warm-Up Day, Thursday August 12th, the rings will be open from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm. We hope that the amendment to these hours will make schooling easier.

On Warm-Up Day with weather permitting we will be having Clear Rounds on the Grand Prix Ring.
