### Board Package Fees

**Package A** (Self Board) \$350.00 + \$42.00 = \$392.00

**Package B** (Semi Board) \$550.00 + \$66.00 = \$616.00

**Package C** (Full Board) \$675.00 + \$81.00 = \$756.00

### First Aid and Veterinary Treatments:

1. Assisting veterinarian with routine vaccinations & worming	\$3.00
2. Assisting veterinarian with dental work	\$10.00 per half hour
3. Assisting veterinarian with lameness exams etc.	\$10.00 per half hour
4. Stable & first aid bandage (with your bandage and supplies)	\$3.00 per application

### Miscellaneous Charges:

7 day turnout weather permitting and paddock cleaning	\$55.00 per month
Holding horse for the Farrier	\$10.00 per half hour

## Barn Rules

1. 30 days notice must be given if you wish to move your horse from the facility.
2. The barn and arenas are closed at 10:00 p.m. If you are the last person to leave please turn off all lights and close all doors. Also if you are not using the lights or radio, please turn them off they are a waste of electricity.
3. No, horses permitted in the Grand Prix Field.
4. On weekends if turning out your own horse please use only your assigned paddock. Horses must be brought in no later than 4:00 p.m.
5. Please clean up after your horse. This includes sweeping up, after grooming, clipping, picking feet and any droppings. Brooms, shovels and wheelbarrows are provided for this purpose. Please clean up after your farrier. Please clean the wash rack after every use.
6. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen property. Please be sure to pick up and put away your property. Anything left out and unclaimed will be put in the lost and found. Unclaimed articles left in the lost and found for over 30 days will be disposed of.
7. We are not responsible for injury of horses on the property.
8. Tie your horse only to the tie rings provided in your stalls. Do not tie to anything else in the barn. Do not leave your horse unattended in the wash rack; the wash rack is for hosing only and not for tacking up horses.
9. If you wish to have your horse left in, please leave a note on your stall or on the whiteboard in a visible spot. If we are not informed in time, the horse will not be brought in by staff until the normal turn in time. Please arrange this for farrier appointments.
10. All self boarders should have a key to the tack room. Keys are available from Jack for a deposit, refundable on key return.
11. Only staff and authorized personnel are allowed in the haylofts, office and feed rooms. Please ask for staff assistance if needed.
12. Please make use of the pay phones located in the Clubhouse lobby and outside the barn office. Office phones are for MREC staff and personnel use only.
13. All dogs must be on a leash at all times. No dogs allowed in the riding arenas. **No exceptions. No Leash = No Dog!**
14. Please put garbage in the garbage cans. Feed bags go in the cardboard recycle bin; staff will pick them up if you leave them neatly piled under the aisle benches. Do not dump old feed or beet pulp in the garbages, please dump these on the manure pile.
15. No, riding in the barn alleyways. No, running or excessively loud noises in barns or arenas. No, smoking in the barns. Abuse or excessive punishment should be reported to the management immediately.
16. Boarders are responsible for cleaning up after their hay deliveries.

## Arena Rules

1. Pass left shoulder to left shoulder. Do not block the rail.
2. No, unmounted people in the arena other than Instructors and assistants.
3. No, loitering in the arenas.
4. Jumps may not be moved by anyone other than Instructors or Staff. In the Jumper ring no distances are to be changed or rails put on the ground. Jumps may be raised or lowered only. Jumps may not be set higher than 3'0" without an Instructor present.
5. No, longeing if there are any riders in the arena.
6. Hard hats with a harness are mandatory for all junior riders (under 19). Hard hats are mandatory for all riders jumping.
7. Riders cooling out please stay to the inside track.
8. Close arena doors and gates as you enter or leave, call out a warning before you open them.
9. We advise riders not to jump alone. All junior riders must jump under supervision, this is mandatory.
10. Horses may not be left unattended in any arenas.
11. You may ride while a lesson is in progress, with Instructor's permission.
12. Do not ride double. Do not ride with a halter and lead rope only. Use appropriate footwear when riding.
13. Absolutely no free-longeing in any of the arenas at any time.
14. The indoor arena must be picked after every ride. There is a wheelbarrow and fork provided.
15. All standards and poles must be dismantled after use and piled in the center of the indoor arena.

## Dike and Cross Country Rules

1. Advise someone when going out in the cross country if you are alone. No jumping in the cross country unless supervised.
2. Do not use jumps if the footing is soft. Hard hats are to be worn at all times.
3. The cross country is closed to all riders one week before each event.

## Other Rules

1. Any damage incurred beyond normal wear and tear of stall or a paddock will be billed to the appropriate boarder.
  2. All boarders are responsible for the cost of broken boards, fence posts, water bowls, gates, feeders, etc. For example \$35.00 per fence post or 20 ft. treated 2"x6". Labour included.
  3. No, blanket changes on horses unless prior arrangements are made.
  4. Keep bathrooms clean and presentable at all times.
  5. Please inspect stalls and paddocks for damage.
  6. Proof of Horse Council B.C. membership is mandatory.
  7. Aside from full board, turnout is provided Monday thru Friday weather permitting. Weekend turnout can be arranged at an additional charge and through previously made arrangements with the staff.
  8. There is no feeding of horses in the paddocks.
  9. Aside from full board, boarders are responsible for cleaning their paddocks or will be charged by staff. Paddock cleaning can be arranged for an additional charge. Anyone or self board or semi board who does not clean their paddocks will be placed on staff paddock cleaning for \$35.00 per month added to your board, no exceptions.
  10. Anyone or self board or semi board who does not clean their stalls daily will be charged a \$10.00 cleaning fee by MREC. By defaulting three times you will be denied the privilege of self or semi board and will be billed for full board.
  11. Please read and adhere to all of the rules set out in this agreement, sign and return to Jack Polo.
