- 1) The Show Management has the right to refuse any entry.
- 2) Everyone may enter on the day of the show. Show office opens at 8:00am and is open the duration of the show.
- 3) All Signatures and entry fees must accompany entries.
- 4) MREC Schooling Shows are conducted under the current Horse Council BC rules. Current memberships are required.
- 5) All competitors must wear ASTM or BSI approved helmets with the safety harness correctly fastened at all times while mounted at MREC. Suitable attire is required for entrants at all times.
- 6) The Show Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill. Classes may be split if entries warrant. **5 riders constitute a class.**
- 7) Abuse of horses will not be tolerated and constitutes grounds for elimination.
- 8) Exhibitors' horses are expected to be sound and in good health. Any horse which Show Management believes to be unsound or unhealthy may be refused entry.
- 9) **ALL** dogs must be leashed at **ALL** times while on the property
