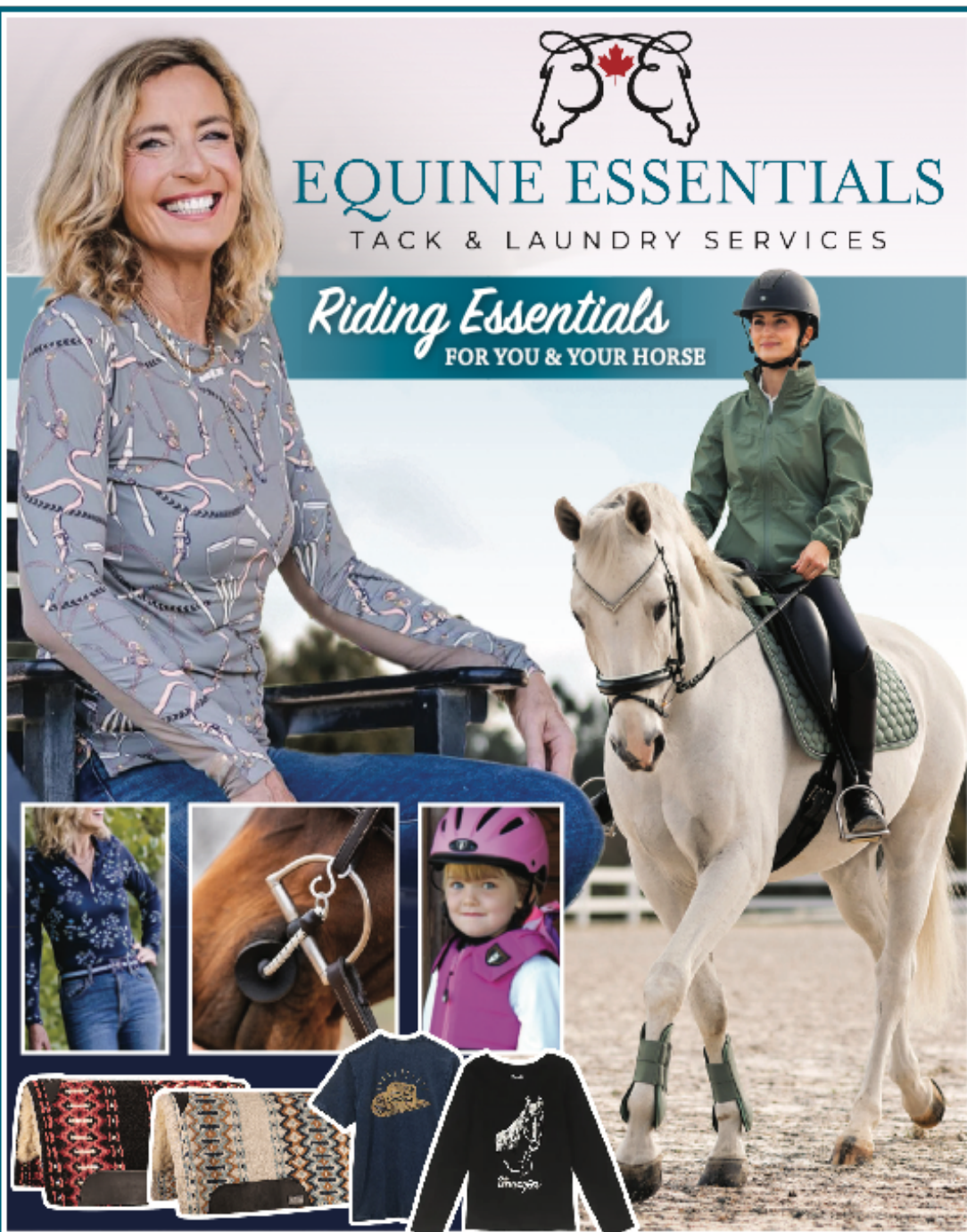

MAPLE RIDGE EQUI-SPORT CENTRE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRIES CLOSE

Closing date for the June Classic – May 28, 2026

Closing date for the August Dog Days of Summer – July 23, 2026

It is the responsibility of the show/event committee, or the organizers and the facility owners and managers to ensure that all BC Health Authority and WorkSafeBC directives are followed and enforced.

Horse Council is not a regulatory body, and it is understood and agreed that sanctioning and approval of either an HCBC Provincial circuit event or Equestrian Canada Bronze or Silver competition relates to the use of the rule book and approved officials only. This Competition is a Horse Council BC provincially sanctioned Competition and will be governed in accordance with the Horse Council BC Rule Book. Knowledge of the Rules is the responsibility of the Competitor.

<https://hcbc.ca/competitions/hcbc-rule-book/> Neither Horse Council BC, its Board of Directors, organizing committee, staff, volunteers, officials, or employees of this horse show will be responsible in any way for damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors, spectators, owners, riders, trainers, or grooms. All competitors and owners of horses must be members of Horse Council BC to participate.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The 2026 MREC June and August Hunter and Jumper Horse Shows are Horse Council BC provincially-sanctioned Competitions and will be governed in accordance with the Horse Council BC Rule Book. Knowledge of the Rules is the responsibility of the Competitor. The Horse Council BC Rule Book, will be used and can be found at the following link: <http://www.hcbc.ca/Competition-Documents.html>

MANAGEMENT

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, arising out of, or incident to the MREC Horse Shows without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered by these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management and their decision is final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders exhibitors, prohibit claim damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges, and to change specifications in jumper classes.

JUNIOR AGES

The age of a rider on January 1 will be maintained throughout the competition year which runs from January 1 to December 31.

- a) Persons born on January 1 will assume the lesser age on that date.
- b) Junior A: a rider who is 15, 16, 17 on January 1
- c) Junior B: a rider who is 12, 13 or 14 on January 1
- d) Junior C: a rider who is under 12 on January 1

ENTRIES

HCBC AND BCHJA MEMBERSHIPS

All owners, riders, lessees and trainers must be current members of Horse Council BC. For competitors wishing to collect BCHJA year end points at BCHJA sanctioned competitions, all riders and trainers/coaches must be current, members of BCHJA.

HCBC ENTRY AGREEMENT

For each horse entered please complete a separate entry form to include: owner and rider information all membership numbers, signatures, payment for: classes entered, stabling fees, exhibitor fees, GST and warm-up fees if required. Membership cards must be presented at check in or copies sent with entry forms.

HCBC MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT DISCIPLINE POLICY

Horse Council BC is committed to providing a safe sport environment in which ethical conduct is respected and promoted. Horse Council BC believes that these values and ideals shall guide the communications and actions of all recognized Coaches and Instructors who are members of HCBC.

The purpose of the HCBC Code of Conduct is to ensure a safe and positive environment within the programs, activities, and events of Horse Council BC consistent with Horse Council BC's core values and policies. Horse Council BC supports equal opportunity, prohibits discriminatory practices, and is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals can safely participate in sport and are treated with respect and fairness.

- The Code and Discipline Policy applies to any Members conduct during the business, activities, and events of Horse Council BC including, but not limited to competitions, practices, evaluations, training sessions, travel associated with organizational activities, the office environment, and any meetings.
- The Code and Discipline Policy also applies to Members conduct outside of the business, activities, and events of Horse Council BC when such conduct adversely affects the organization's relationships (and the work and sport environment) or is detrimental to the image and reputation of Horse Council BC. Such applicability will be determined by Horse Council BC at its sole discretion.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

For each horse entered please complete a separate entry form to include: owner and rider information, all membership numbers, signatures, payment for: classes entered, stabling or haul-in fees, exhibitor fees, GST and warm-up fees if required. Membership cards must be presented at check in or copies sent with entry forms.

Full payment of the show bill due upon completion of the horse show. NSF cheques/declined credit cards are subject to a \$50.00 fee. The credit card indicated on the entry form will be responsible for the deposit and all other fees related to the entry. Changes to the card responsible for the entry may be made for future changes

but refunds for past charges due to a change of the card will incur a \$25.00 fee. Refunds due to entries submitted in error by customer will also incur a \$25.00 fee. Only show scratched and substitutions will have deposits refunded without a fee. We accept cash, cheques, payable to MREC in Canadian Funds, mailed with the entry form to **21973 – 132 Ave, Maple Ridge, BC, V4R 2T1**, debit, e-transfer and alternatively credit card with a 3% Convenience Fee.

NUMBERS

Numbers will **NOT** be issued unless all signatures are in place, all memberships are current and listed, and all fees have been paid by cheque or credit card. This includes: fully paid current owner, rider and trainer, Horse Council and EC memberships, all signatures, and all entries paid in full. A credit card number or an open cheque must be left with the entry secretary if competitors wish to add classes during the competition. Equitation riders not riding their own horse must sign the form (and have a parent or guardian sign if a junior rider) for the horse they are riding and use that horse's number.

Every entry must be provided an identification number by the competition organizing committee which must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and/or exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.

At the MREC Hunter Jumpers competitions every entry must wear the competition number issued by the Horse Show Office. This number must be worn at all times when the horse is out of the stall. Bridle numbers are not sufficient. Failure to do so, may result in elimination!

RETURNED PAYMENT

Cheques returned by the bank for any reason or credit cards that do not go through will be assessed a penalty of \$50.00. Payment must be repaid within 10 days and be paid by certified cheques, money order, cash, Visa or Mastercard and must include the \$50.00 fee.

POST ENTRIES

Horses entering after the start of the show will pay a late fee of \$35 and be subject to all add/scratch fees.

SUBSTITUTIONS

With a Veterinarian's certificate a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$25 substitution fee and all monies will be transferred to the new horse.

ADD/SCRATCHES: CHANGE POLICY

- **ALL** entries will be charged a one-time \$20.00 fee for adding, scratching or changing classes.
- A credit card or open cheque must be left at the show office before any add/scratch/changes will be processed.
- Any class adds, scratches, or changes **MUST** be made in the show office in writing no later than ½ hour after the last class the day before the class is scheduled.

SAME DAY CLASS ADD, SCRATCH, CHANGES

- Scratching or changing a class at the gate will not constitute an official scratch or change. Scratches and changes **MUST** be made in the office before the start of the class for a full refund.
- Same day class adds will be charged a \$5.00 fee per class.
- Classes **CAN NOT** be added or changed once the class starts.
- Competitors that go into a class without entering will pay **double the fee of the class.**

REFUNDS

- **CANCELLATION BEFORE CLOSING DATE** - Before closing date of entries a full refund will be given.
- **CANCELLATION AFTER CLOSING DATE BUT BEFORE THE START OF THE HORSE SHOW** - STALL FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. Upon the presentation of a Vet Slip to the entry secretary the entry fees, exhibitor fees, and warm up fees will be refunded, minus an office fee of \$25 or 15% whichever is greater.

- **CANCELLATION AFTER THE START OF THE HORSE SHOW** - Upon presentation of a Vet Slip to the entry secretary, class fees for the classes that have not been shown in, will be refunded, minus a \$25 or 15% fee whichever is greater. Stall fee and exhibitor fees will not be refunded.

NON-SHOWING FEE

All Non-Showing horses and riders will be charged \$75.00

EXHIBITOR FEE

All entries will be charged a \$40.00 fee.

CHECK OUT

All accounts must be checked out at the end of the show. Any account that is not checked by 5 pm Sunday will be charged as is and will not be open to dispute after the show.

BARN BILLS & TRAINER SPLITS

Trainers requiring barn bills must set them up at the beginning of the horse show with a credit card or open cheque. Trainer splits must be done by no later than Saturday.

HAUL IN FEE

Horses that are not renting a stall and are trailering in and out must pay a haul in fee of \$20 per horse per day. Horses hauling in for warm-up day only, will pay the following fee per horse. \$40 Administration, \$25 Medic fee and the cost of warm-up ticket(s).

RV PARKING

Parking is available for RVs and campers for the fee of \$20.00 per day. There are no hook-up however pay showers are available on the grounds.

SCHOOLING

Schooling will be available for hunters and jumpers over a posted course on Thursday from 9:00am to 4:00pm. The cost is \$30.00 for the day. Sand Hunter Ring, Fences - 2'6"– 2'9". Sand Jumper Ring, Fences 0.75m(2'6") and 0.90m(3'0"). Numbers must be worn for schooling. Riders wishing to show only on schooling day may do so, but must fill out a waiver, obtain a number and pay appropriate fees in the show office before schooling. Adults are permitted to ride ponies in schooling areas and in non-judged warm-up rounds. Horses hauling in for warm-up day only, will pay the following fee per horse, \$40 Administration Fee, \$25.00 Medic Fee and the cost of warm-up. Schooling times may be adjusted at discretion of management.

STABLING

STABLING and CLEAN OUT

Stalls occupied by a horse will be available at the rate of \$170.00 per stall plus \$90.00 for unlimited shavings. Stalls that will be used for feed and tack stalls will be available for \$170.00. There will be an additional \$75.00 charge per horse stall for clean out. **Once the stall has been broom-swept clean upon departure (including all hay, garbage, etc.) and the horse show office has been notified, the \$75.00 will be refunded. There will be no stall clean out fee refund if the horse show office has not been notified.** Stabling will be available beginning Wednesday morning after 9AM, ending Sunday. **Please contact Nayda at 604 839-8292 to book stalls.**

BEDDING

Bedding is available on the show grounds. A fee of \$90.00 will be charged per horse stall.

MANURE

Manure must be placed in the designated area. Trash must be kept separate from manure and placed in appropriate receptacles.

HCBC PROTOCOL

CONCUSSION

Accidents & Return to Play rule: In the event of a fall/accident where a concussion can be reasonably suspected, the competitors must receive medical clearance by qualified medical personnel on-site before continuing to compete. The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the on-site medical assessment takes place. Should a competitor refuse to be evaluated, they will be disqualified from the competition. If on-site qualified medical personnel suspect a concussion or believe the competitor may be at risk of concussion due to the nature of the fall or impact, the competitor will be suspended from competition and placed on a Medical Suspension List until medically released. Competitors will remain on the Medical Suspension List until they submit a Return to Play declaration, provided by and signed by a licensed physician to HCBC Manager Competition and Sport and MREC Competition Manager. No competitor shall compete at provincially sanctioned competitions while on the Medical Suspension List and competition management may refuse entry to anyone currently on the list.

FALLS

All competitors that have had a fall during training/warm up on the Competition site or in the Competition Arena/Field of Play must be assessed by qualified medical personnel onsite before they either take part in another test or competition. Competitors must not re-mount their horse until this assessment has been completed. The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the onsite medical assessment takes place by the onsite qualified medical personnel.

CRUELTY, ABUSE, OR INHUMANE TREATMENT OF HORSES

Abuse of the horse is strictly forbidden. Abuse includes, but is not restricted to, excessive use of spurs, abuse of the whip and brutal use of the reins during halts or rein backs, repeated tugs on the horse's mouth.

1. The abuse or inhumane treatment of a horse by an individual sport license holder or other person at an EC-sanctioned competition shall not be tolerated under any circumstances. 2. The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which, a person informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures, would determine to be cruel, abusive or inhumane. Any treatment or practice that causes undue stress, and/or pain, is deemed abusive. Sensory hairs of the head may remain unclipped or unshaven, but removal will not be penalized.

PROTESTS

Should any questions or disputes arise which are not provided for in the rulebooks, they shall be referred to the Show Committee whose decision will be final.

ATTIRE

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

At all HCBC-sanctioned competitions, **anyone mounted on a horse**, including foreign competitors, must wear approved equestrian head gear, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times. Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headwear with the attached safety harness fastened.

DRESS

All competitors must be properly dressed in the confines of the arena. This includes the inspection of the course and at the presentation of prizes. Black or brown **smooth** leather half chaps are permissible providing they match the boot color. In jumper competitions open-neck polo shirts are allowed. No sweatshirts, t-shirts, tank tops or other similar dress will be permitted. Shirts must be neatly tucked into riding breeches.

EARPHONES AND EARBUDS

Earphones/Earbuds and/or other electronic communication devices are strictly prohibited in the competition arena, and such usage is penalized by elimination.

The use of only one earphone/earbud is allowed while mounted everywhere within the grounds of the Event except the competition arena. When mounted, only handsfree communication is permitted at MREC

AWARDS

RIBBONS AND CHAMPIONSHIPS

All hunter, jumper and equitation classes will be placed 1st through 6th. Championship prizes will be awarded in divisions of 3 competitors or more. In the case of less than 3 competitors in a division, only championship ribbons will be awarded.

A minimum of three classes is required for championships in HCBC-sanctioned competitions.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money in regular classes will be divided as follows: 1st place-40%, 2nd place-30%, 3rd place-20%, 4th place-10%. Special classes will state the money breakdown in each class specification. Prize money will be paid in Canadian funds. All prize money will be put as a credit to the appropriate account, and anything owing will be deducted. The remaining prize money will be paid to the owner listed on the entry form unless other arrangements have been made. Prize money will be mailed within 30 days from the last day of the conclusion of the competition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LIABILITY

All owners and competitors and trainers are personally responsible for damages to persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. The owners and competitors and trainers **MUST** have third party insurance to provide full coverage for participation in equestrian events at any of the MREC Hunter Jumper Shows. Neither MREC Holdings Ltd. DBA Maple Ridge Equi-Sport Centre nor, nor their organizing committee, board of directors, sponsors, employees, volunteers nor contractors shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, death, damage, loss or any other matter that may happen, from any causes or circumstances whatsoever to competitors, exhibitors, or members of their family or their agents, or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on to Maple Ridge Equi-Sport Centre property, or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or attributable to any of the MREC Hunter Jumper Horse Shows.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS

The horse show office will be open Thursday from 8:00am to 5:00pm. During horse show days, the office will open one hour before the first class and until ½ hour after the last class.

FOOTING

Sand footing

SMOKING

Please observe all posted signs and no smoking at least 10 meters for all barns.

FARRIER

A Farrier will be on the show grounds the days of the show and on call for warm-up day.

DOGS

All dogs must be on a controlled leash on the show grounds. Absolutely no dogs in the schooling or show arenas at any time.

LUNGING

No free lunging at any time in any of the arenas. A designated lunging area will be provided.

A 1st Year Green horse has never competed over fences of 3' or higher prior to Jan. 1 of the current year at an EC sanctioned competition. A 2nd Year Green horse has never competed over fences higher than 3'3" prior to Jan. 1 of the current year at an HCBC-sanctioned competition. No Green hunter may jump 3'6" or higher without jeopardizing their green status

The officiating steward, judge, technical delegate, president of the ground jury or appointed competition veterinarian has the authority to remove a horse from the event for a period of up to 24 hours, if in their reasonable opinion the horse is unfit to compete, or where, in their reasonable opinion, there is a safety concern regarding the horse. The official's decision is final and cannot be appealed. In the case of a fall of an Athlete anywhere within the grounds of the event during the hours of competition operation, the Athlete must be checked by the Competition's medical service, before the Athlete may continue to compete in the next round or Competition. The competitor is solely responsible for ensuring the onsite medical assessment takes place. This rule is applicable to all competitors (including foreign) at HCBC sanctioned events and applies to falls/accidents that occur at the event location.

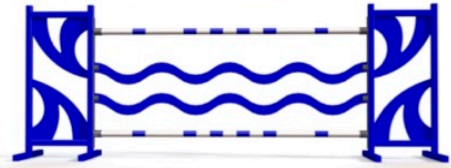
